EXETER 40623	Bridge replacement to address Priority Bridge carrying NH111A over Little River (Br No 075/078)	(\$337,388)	\$4,339,905	ROW and CON delayed on project resulting in decreased TIP funding
PORTSMOUTH 20258	Construct new sidewalk and striped bicycle shoulders and associated drainage along Peverly Hill Road	(\$5,014,140)	\$8,295,051	Most CON delayed beyond 2026 resulting in decreased TIP funding
PROGRAM BRIDGE T1/2-M&P	Maintenance & Preservation of Tier 1 & 2 bridges	\$8,425,000	\$202,057,000	Increased funds to support planned child project needs
