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












2015 NHDOT / USGS 1' Aerial Photo

The New Hampshire Department of Transportation partnered with the US Geological Survey (USGS) and additional state and federal partners to acquire high resolution, leaf-off, color, aerial photography. This 1' (.35m) GSD multispectral digital orthoimagery was compiled to meet a 3.0 meter (9.84') horizontal accuracy at 95% confidence level based on NSSDA testing guidelines. These images were geometrically corrected to achieve a uniform scale. Each frame was adjusted for topographic relief, lens distortion and camera tilt. The NH Department of Transportation shall not be held liable for any errors in this data. This includes errors of omission, errors of commission, content errors, and relative and positional accuracy errors in the data. This data should not be construed to be a legal document.
