




1) What town do you live in?




2) How long have you lived there?




3) How would you rate your town as a place for people to live as older adults?



4) How would you rate your town as a place to attract/keep younger people in their 20s and 30s?




5) How important is it to you to remain in your town as you reach your 70s, 80s and beyond?





7) What if anything concerns you most about growing into older adulthood in your community? (check all that apply)









18) Do you have family or friends nearby who can provide you with assistance now or in the future for things like running errands, transportation, cooking, and self-care?





19) How likely is it that you will provide care to an adult family member or friend in the future?





21) How frequently do you eat nutritious meals?









26) Beside yourself, who else lives in your household? (check all that apply)





28) If you would like to have more social contact with others, what prevents you from doing so? (check all that apply)









31) What is your age?




32) What race(s) do you identify with? (check all that apply)



33) Do you consider yourself Hispanic, Latino/Latina, or of Spanish origin?




34) What is your gender?





35) What is your current employment status? (check all that apply)



36) What is the highest degree or level of school you have completed? (If you are currently enrolled in school, please indicate the level of study completed so far)


