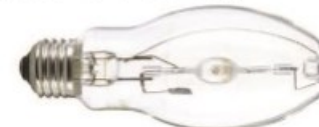

Beginning in 2025, the Exeter Household Hazardous Waste Collection will no longer accept hazardous bulbs. Contact your local transfer station—most accept hazardous bulbs. You can also safely dispose of these bulbs at the following locations:

- 4ft tubes = \$2.49 per bulb
- 8ft tubes = \$5.49 per bulb
