- CFLs = \$1.99 per bulb
- 4ft tubes = \$2.49 per bulb
- 8ft tubes = \$13.99 per bulb

Batteries Plus, Salem

- Types of bulbs accepted—ballasts, circular fluorescents, cold cathode, CFLs, fluorescent tubes, germicidal and UV lamps, halogen, high pressure sodium, incandescent, LED, plastic coated and shatter shield, mercury vapor, metal halide, U-bend fluorescent
- CFLs = \$1.99 per bulb
- 4ft tubes = \$2.49 per bulb
- 8ft tubes = \$5.49 per bulb
